Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of School of Homoeopathy, Sri Satya Sai University of Technology and Medical Sciences, SH 18, Bhopal, Indore Road, opposite oil fed plant, Pachama, District Sehere, Sehere- 466001 for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and for PG with intake capacity of total 15 seats in 05 subjects namely 03 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 03 seats Organon of Medicine, 03 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine for academic year 2025-26 – reg.

Sir,

School of Homoeopathy, Sri Satya Sai university of technology and medical science, SH 18, Bhopal, Indore Road, opposite oil fed plant, Pachama, District Sehere, Sehere- 466001 is functional since 2016, and has applied for permission for sanction of 100 seats in BHMS course and total 15 seats in 05 subjects namely 03 seats in Homoeopathic Pharmacy, 03 seats Organon of Medicine, 03 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine in PG course for the academic year 2025-26. The College has submitted the Part I information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. MARBH conducted Inspection on 16.05.2025 and 17.05.2025 followed by Virtual hearing on 20/06/2025. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards as per the prevailing regulations under clauses 26 and 28 of the NCH Act 2020. On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board observed the following shortfalls: -

1. Deficiency of Teaching Faculty (3 deficiencies)

• In UG

- In Department of Repertory 1 Assistant professor is deficient.
- In Department of Materia Medica 1 Associate professor and 1 Assistant Professor are deficient.

• In PG- (2 deficiencies)

• Dr. Umesh Kumar Pandey is Principal of the college and Professor in Department of Materia Medica.

- In Department of Research methodology and biostatistics 1 Professor and 1 Associate Professor are deficient.

As evident from the above statement, a total number of three teachers are deficient against the requirement of 40+1 for 100 seats UG college (As specified in MES,2024). Pursuant to F.No.: 3-2/MARBH/NCH/2025-26/162-169 dated 16/04/2025 issued by MARBH, a college up to 100 seats can avail 10% relaxation against the required number of teachers for Academic Year 2025-26 only. After allowing relaxation of 10%, college has no deficiency. However, such relaxed number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

There is also deficiency of one Professor and one Associate Professor in Postgraduate Department of Research Methodology and Biostatistics. However, such deficient number of teachers may be appointed at the earliest for smooth conduct of course.

2. Hospital Information:

- Clinical Teaching room is not functional because it is under development.

3. Miscellaneous:

i. NABH/NABL accreditation not applied.

4. Considering the above observations during inspection and virtual hearing, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to School of Homoeopathy, Sri Satya Sai university of technology and medical sciences, SH 18, Bhopal, Indore Road, opposite oilfield plant, Pachama, District Sehore, Sehore- 466001 for continuing UG (BHMS) course with intake capacity of 100 seats for academic year 2025 – 26, on the basis of following conditions: -**

- i. Clinical teaching room are currently under development; they should be completed and made operational.
- ii. Apply for NABH/NABL accreditation.

The institute will rectify all the above deficiencies within a month and compliance shall be submitted to MARBH, failing which permission may be withdrawn.

5. MARBH has decided to give **Conditional permission to the college for continuing PG course with intake of 15 seats, namely Organon of Medicine and Homoeopathic Philosophy with 03 seats, Homoeopathic Materia Medica with 03 seats, Homoeopathy Pharmacy with 03 seats, Homoeopathic Repertory and case taking with 03 seats and Practice of Medicine with 03 seats for academic year 2025-26, on the basis of following conditions: -**

- i. 02 faculty members in Department of Research Methodology and biostatistics must be appointed.


The institute will rectify all the above deficiencies within a month and compliance shall be submitted to MARBH, failing which permission may be withdrawn.

6. All admissions shall be made from NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 seats for BHMS and 15 seats for M.D.(Hom.) course shall be treated as All India Quota. Counselling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by the Central Government and counselling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned counseling authority of the state/UT designated by Central Government. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Govt. for All India Quota or the student admitted thereunder.

7. The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.
